

Covid Care

Please only enter the school site using the **One-way system** – the children will always use the main entrance to enter and exit. So in the morning parents will enter via the main gate and leave via the side gate. In the afternoon please enter through the side gate and leave through the main gate.

Please ensure you **wear a face covering** when on the school site.

Children will be asked to wash their hands on entry and before leaving school as well as during the day.

Please do be sure to respect the

social distancing

requirements whilst waiting for your child to come out of class – especially as the weather warms up. Please do not allow your children to play on the equipment at the end of the school day.

We must continue to reduce bubble mixing in school to keep us all safe.
