Secondary School Applications

Secondary applications for our current Y6 need to be completed by 31st October to be considered on-time. This can be done via the admission portal via the CWAC website. Notification of offers will be 2 March 2026. The process is the same for all our Y6 pupils including those with EHCPs. The closing date for Reception 2026 applications is 15th January 2026.

Punctuality

We now have an improved system in school for our entry management on the gate, school door and hall doors. These are programmed for key times in the day to be unlocked. The main gate will be open from 8.35am. It will also open again at the end of the day. Just a reminder, also, that the school day begins at 8.45am when the children line up on the school playground. There are a range of important systems in place in the morning that support the children significantly.

Late Collection

Whilst we appreciate that there are times when we are all unavoidably late, we have had to review our late collection procedure. From Monday 6th October any child who is still at school 10 minutes after pick up will be placed into Buddies and charged accordingly. Many thanks for your support in this.



Please could we ask that all parents take care when travelling to and from school and when parking. The speed through Kingsley Village is 20 mph once you reach Pike Lane. Please also be mindful of our neighbors when parking at the beginning and the end of the day. Many thanks for your support.
